The Real Story of the Golden Gate to Spruce Goose Chase

Part 1 of 2

Here's the real story of the Golden Gate to Spruce Goose Chase as told from a competitor's point of view in the cockpit of the Chris-Craft 312 Stinger.

"THE GREAT AMERICAN RACE" - The Golden Gate to Spruce Goose Chase to benefit the 1984 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles, California.

The story all started after Los Angeles was selected to host the 1984 Summer Olympics. For the first time in history, an Olympics was to be held without government support. The burden of raising the millions of dollars required to host such an event all had to come from contributions,

sponsorships and fund raising

Peter Ueberroth was elected Chairman of the LA Olympic Committee and his first effort was a fund raising effort. Shortly after that, for the first time ever, a television broadcast company, ABC,

paid \$225 million for the rights to broadcast the Summer Olympics. After that, sponsorships and contributions started pouring in, and soon it became obvious that Mr.

to showcase offshore powerboat racing pass by.

In the fall of 1983, Bob approached Mr. Ueberroth with the conception of a powerboat race from the for the right to participate in the race. The race was to have four legs, the start at the San Francisco Yacht Club, a fuel stop in Monterrey Bay, an overnight stop in Morro



Ueberroth was on his way to producing the first Olympics in history without support of government funds of any nature.

Bob Nordskog, a native Californian, publisher of "Powerboat Magazine", and a noted offshore racer in his own right, was not one to let an opportunity Golden Gate Bridge to Long Beach harbor (location of the Queen Mary and the famous "Spruce Goose" built by none other than Howard Hughes). It was to be called "The Golden Gate to Spruce Goose Chase", and Bob told Mr. Ueberroth that he would solicit powerboat companies to contribute \$25,000 each

Bay, another fuel stop in Santa Barbara and the finish at the Queen Mary. Bob told Peter that he would solicit sponsors at each stop, and that overall he planned to raise over \$250,000 to support the 1984 Olympics. Mr. Ueberroth bought into the idea, and the "Golden Gate to Spruce Goose Chase" was

officially announced in the Fall of 1983.

Bob produced an entry packet for the race, and the packets were mailed out to a select group of companies who were producing boats of a size suitable for offshore racing.

By January, 1984, seven companies, Chris-Craft, Wellcraft, Fountain, Cigarette, Baja, Formula and Cobalt had all ponied up the \$25,000 entry fee.

In January 1984, at the New York Boat Show, Mercury Marine (one of the non-boat sponsors) held a lottery drawing for the engines which were to be used bν each boat company in the race. The engines were 370HP Mercruiser Sterndrives. and were serial numbered and factory sealed to be sure that none of the companies tried to tamper with the engines before the race. Each company drew two serial numbers from the hat, and those were the engines shipped to each company for use in their race boat. The only option allowed on the engine package was each companies selection of props to use.

In January, 1984, Chris-Craft started construction of the 312 Stinger that was to be used in the race. While the boat was to be a "factory production" boat, including a full cabin with upholstery, Bob did allow certain items to be added or modified in the sake of safety. The 312 Stinger included a balsa cored hull featuring **Kyntex** fiberglass, lexian windshield, racing bolster and two high seats capacity bilge pumps and a larger compass (keep in mind, at that time GPS for powerboats did not exist). Other than that. modification were made.

The race was originally scheduled for the end of March, but Mr. Nordskog, being a native Californian, realized that March in California can be quite unpredictable weatherwise, announced that the race would be postponed until mid-May.


After our Chris-Craft was finished and prior to shipment to San Francisco, Dick Genth. President of Chris-Craft and driver of the boat, insisted that we test the boat on local waters prior to shipment. "The last thing I want to happen is we get to San Francisco only to discover that we have an engine problem".

Over the Easter Weekend, John McCoy our test engineer and myself, Executive Vice President of Chris-Craft and navigator of the 312 Stinger, spent over 15 hours running the boat from Sarasota to Tampa Bay down to Sanibel and back to be sure there were no hiccups in the engines. Shortly after, the boat was transported to San Francisco to await our arrival.

We, and our families, left on Thursday, May 10th for Francisco. San The planned schedule was for testing on San Francisco Bay on Friday morning, with a boat parade Friday afternoon and a gala cocktail party and banquet that Friday night. The wind kicked up around noon, and with waves of 4-5 feet in the Bay, the boat parade was cancelled. At the banquet that night, Bob announced that the weather forecast for Saturday and Sunday (the days of the race) was deteriorating quickly, and that fog and high winds were forecast for all weekend up and down the coast. A drivers meeting was to be held at the San Francisco Yacht Club early Saturday morning at which time further weather updates would be discussed.

All night long (couldn't really sleep) I kept looking out my window at a flag atop the building across the street. Between breaks in the fog, the flag

was standing straight out! Not a good omen. Part 2 of this fantastic article will be published in next month's newsletter.



I'm in my mid 70's and have been a boat person all my life, and I might add that I operated a full service boat company for several years. I'm guite capable of handling any mechanical, wood or fiberglass challenges. I'm retired and I have time on my hands, so I applied myself and brought this boat up to my standards. I also have many friends in the boat business so there's very little I or they can't handle. This boat has twin 260HP, 350cu/in engines with Alpha One outdrives. It has a Teak swim platform as wells a 3 blade stainless props. I repaired the dings and scratches on the hull, prepped then painted the hull. I used the original colors for the base cote then clear coated it. Over the years I made several changes (they're listed below) because I had the ability, time and finances. I've always used Mobil 1 15/50 in the engines along with Merc oil filters. All the parts and upgrades I have used on this boat were from Mercrusier. At present the exterior of this boat is as new as are all the cushions and seats. I never got to the cabin which could use some updating. Upgrades and Enhancements that I have done to this boat. Paint entire exterior using original colors. 2010 Recovered and replaced the foam in all cushions and seats 2010 Installed remote oil filter up grade (for easy access.) 2010 Installed new exhaust manifolds & risers (center type risers.) 2011 Installed through the transom exhaust system (using 4" polished stainless) 2011 Complete ignition upgrade to Thunderbolt IV 2011 All new shift and throttle cables 2012 New Quicksilver controls 2012 Install onboard marine battery charger 2013 Install new trim and tilt sensors 2013 Complete Drive service on both drives 2014 Rebuild both Carbs. 2014 Installed new pedestals on front seats Added batteries (boat now has 4 batteries.) Installed battery guick disconnect switches Installed crossover switches for emergency starting

I have a super rare 88' chris craft stinger 202 for sale. It has 165 hours on the hull. This boat is like brand new. I literally just finished it. This is the coolest fiberglass speedboat that Chris Craft ever made and was made for the Miami Vice ty series. They were built in very limited quantities and there are only a handful of these left. There is a website dedicated to them, I know of no other boats that have a cult following. I built this one to be better than it was originally. It is an attention grabber. I get compliments on it wherever I am and have had numerous offers on it even before I restored it. I'm selling it because I'm getting married and need the money. I just put well over \$7500 into it this summer alone and have well over 12K into it total. I had planned to use it but sadly, it needs to go. Weddings are insanely expensive and I'm finding out the hard way. I replaced the motor and outdrive. It has an OMC 4.3L v-6 and an OMC cobra outdrive. Next, I gutted the boat completely and installed

new marine ply, fiberglass, carpet, custom-built seats and engine cover and had everything professionally upholstered. I installed a new GT steering wheel, a Sony marine cd/mp3/satellite radio, which sounds awesome, a new bilge pump, new fuel lines, new aluminum swivel/slider/adjustable height seat posts and new Tracker style folding seats. The interior work cost over \$4K alone but was well worth it. It came out awesome. I had a 4bbl. Rochester carb installed which brings the HP up to 205 and will do over 60MPH. I had the pin striping re-done on the boat and matching Shorelander trailer. I replaced the tires, lights, and started to strip and repaint the entire trailer. It also has a new deep cycle battery. There are 2 swim platforms molded into the stern that have teak footboards and they were also refinished and look great. I also just purchased a new trailerable cover for it. I even just filled the tank with ethanol free 93octane fuel. I'm probably forgetting a lot. If you're interested you must include the words eighty-eight chris craft to get a response due to spammers. I know it's the wrong time of the year to sell a boat and I could get more for it this spring which is why I priced it where it is. It is well worth the money. Chris craft builds the very best boats around and this one is better than new.
